WHEREAS, the City of Casselberry encourages the increased use of the bicycle, benefiting all citizens of Casselberry by improving air quality, reducing traffic congestion and noise, decreasing the use of and dependence upon finite energy sources, fostering exercise, and promoting a healthy community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Casselberry, recognizing the use of bicycles as a viable mode of transportation, endeavors to promote safe and responsible bicycling and is committed to incorporating the development of bicycle facilities as part of the City's transportation system, as evidenced in its recently adopted Multimodal Transportation Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, May is National Bike Month; and

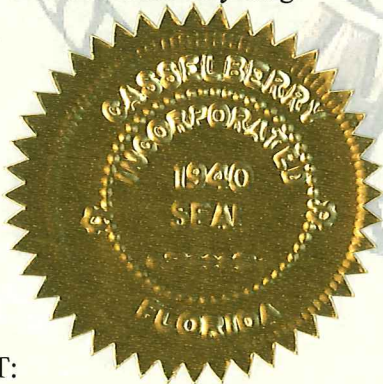
